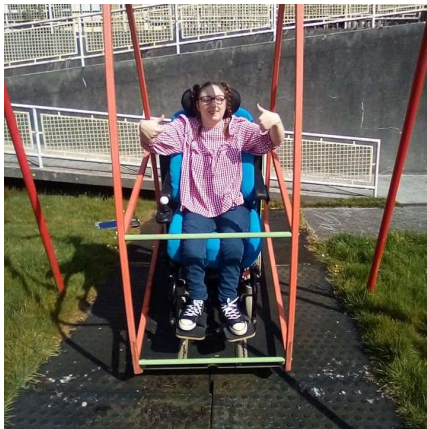


Pool Time
